- Demonstrate through the "On Click" effect, bullet points in the slides can be presented more effectively

Designing Slides through injecting the "On Click" effect

• Participants to employ the "On Click" effect when redesigning a slide with more than 5 bullets points which are shown all at once

Designing Effective Charts, "3 Big Questions" Technique

- Show examples of charts with overwhelming and unnecessary amount of data and elements
- Show examples of charts that are effectively designed
- Explain to participants about applying the "3 Big Questions" technique when designing their charts

Designing Effective Charts through applying the "3 Big Questions" Technique

• Participants to employ the "3 Big Questions" Technique when redesigning a slide with overwhelming and unnecessary amount of data and elements

Websites with Freebies

- Show 3 photos that are legitimate
- Participants will be given a deck of slides which are badly designed
- Participants to apply the techniques learned throughout the day and redesign a deck of slides
